District Governor Visit

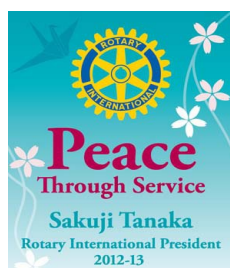
Our Rotary District Governor

A Look Back-History of the Keosauqua Rotary Club

The Keosauqua Rotary club was
chartered on June 27, 1955 by the
sponsoring Ottumwa Rotary Club. The
first meeting was held on June 28, 1955
in the Zephyr Room of the Goodie
Garden Café. Charter Night was held at
the Keosauqua High School on
September 9, 1955 with the following
clubs participating and making
presentations: Ottumwa (Rotary Bell and
Gavel), Mt. Pleasant (Music), Bloomfield
& Fairfield (Charter Members Buttons),
Washington (Rotary Banner), Burlington
(Club Record), Iowa City (Speaker's
Stand), Ft. Madison & Keokuk (Highway
Signs).
