More than 25% of this total has been applied directly to the eradication of polio around the globe. The original campaign took place in the mid-1980's. With the partnership of the United Nations, World Health Organization, UNICEF, and the Gates Foundation, Rotary has successfully eradicated polio from 99.9% of the world -the dangerous one-tenth that remains is now the final goal of this greatest of all humanitarian projects.

Our club Foundation giving through December, 2008 was \$1416 toward our 2009 Rotary year goal of \$2100.
